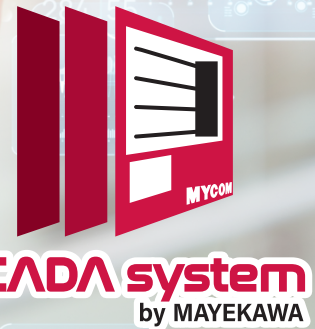


SCADA system can display:
